Subj: RESTORAL OF MCRC PROGRAMMED FUNDS ASSOCIATED WITH  
NAVY/MARINE CORPS INTRANET (NMCI) INITIATIVES

1. During the development of the NMCI program, my staff realized MCRC needed to augment our total requirement by applying an additional \$5.3 million from existing resources. Our initial programmed amount was \$10.2 million and is resident at MCSC for execution. To increase our NMCI program, MCRC gave up specific Operations and Maintenance (O&M) dollars to P&R through the programming system off cycle from FY 2004-2009. Your staff assured me that funding would be pulled and returned if NMCI could not support MCRC's requirements. As of 28 January 2004, the MCSC NMCI program office agrees MCRC's \$5.3 million increase for NMCI should be returned. Further, we expect this situation to continue into FY 2005.
2. Since MCRC must continue to support our Information Technology (IT) infrastructure in support of recruiters in the field, please allow MCSC to return FY04 funds in the amount of \$5.3 million for transfer into MCRC's O&M account.
